Position: **National Medical Director**

Location: Remote

Salary: \$35-40,000/yr (Part-Time)

Compassion & Choices is seeking a **National Medical Director** to help advance our medical outreach and education efforts across the country.

This position is primarily responsible for consulting with physicians through the Doc-to-Doc program, providing guidance on advance planning issues, and acting as a spokesperson and presenter for the organization.

This is a **part-time (15 hours per week)**, remotely-located, paid position reporting to the National Director of Integrated Programs. Compensation offered will be commensurate with experience.

This position will primarily:

- Act as an official spokesperson and represent the organization with the media, as a presenter, an educator, and through written materials.
- Serve as the major resource for physician education about end-of-life choices including the medical aid-in-dying process.
- Oversee the on-going evaluation and development of medication protocols.
- Help manage the Doc-to-Doc program and provide comprehensive end-of-life information and support to physicians in both medical aid-in-dying authorized and non-authorized states..
- Serve as a medical resource and provide clinical expertise in team meetings, and as needed, to EOLC consultants, staff, clients, volunteers and affiliated medical professionals for the delivery of services.
- Assist in improving care and expanding choice in all 50 states. Assist with advocacy efforts including testifying to legislators. Assist in locating physicians and pharmacists willing to provide the services. Assists in making sure appropriate medications are available to clients in specific cities or states.
- Maintain confidentiality of our clients, their family members and participating physicians and pharmacists.
- Be willing and able to travel across the nation to participate in presentations, to testify in front of legislators, to provide education to physicians, or other as needed.

Preferred Qualifications (You will be a good fit):

Education and Experience:

- Medical degree (M.D or D.O).
- Ten (10) years directly related experience in clinical or medical setting:
 - Experience in hospice or palliative care a strong plus
- Malpractice insurance is not required except by personal preference.

Skills:

- Excellent public speaking and presentation skills
- Knowledgeable about issues of choice, ethics, health and social justice.
- Ability to earn the confidence of a wide range of internal and external constituents.
