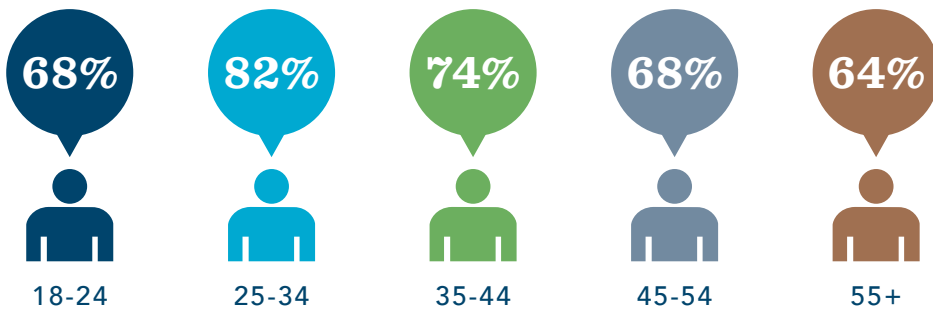


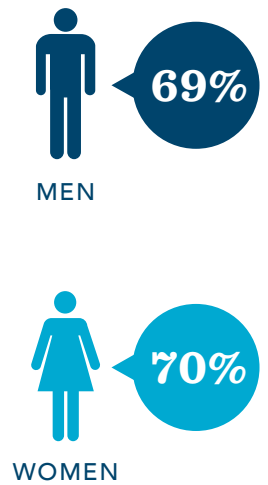
# 7 in 10 Virginians Support Medical Aid in Dying

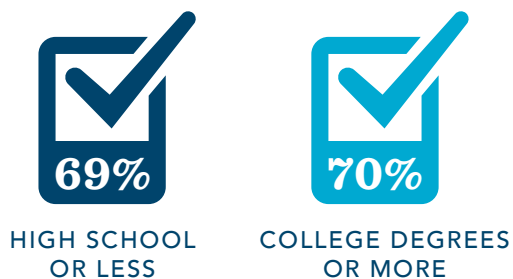

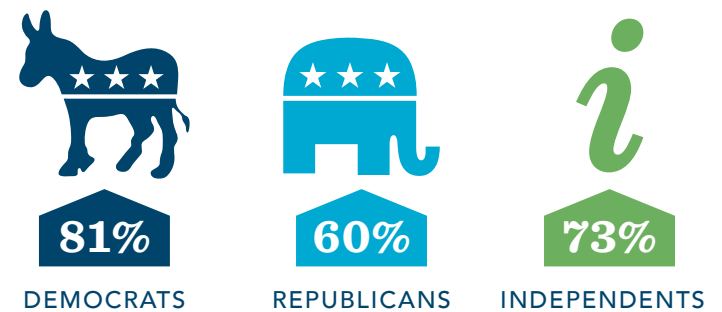
## GENDER



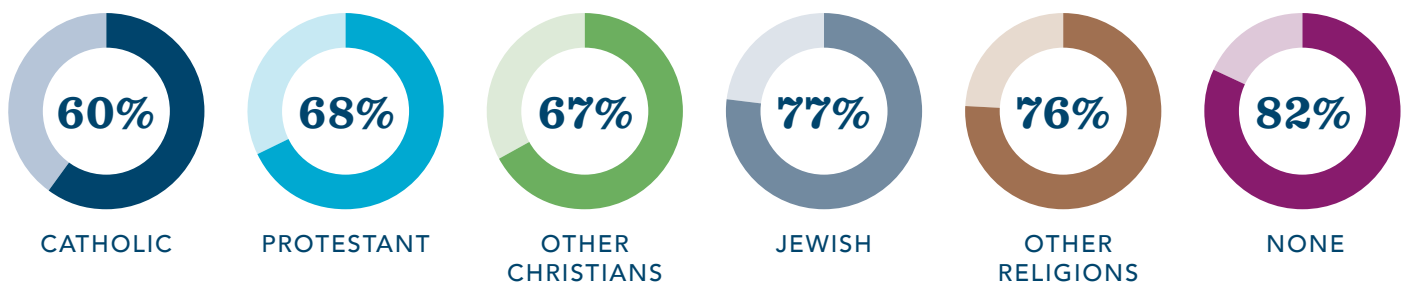
## EDUCATION LEVEL
